## 2017 CUSHING-GAVIN AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Nominations should be accompanied by as much detail as possible about the candidate's career. **Please provide a statement why YOU BELIEVE the nominee is worthy of the award. Consider nominating an individual in each category.**

FOUR awards are presented each year to **actively functioning** representatives

1. **Union Official** – either elected or appointed.
2. **Management Representative** – either public or private sector.
3. **Rev. Edward F. Boyle, SJ – Auxiliary** – embraces such groups as arbitrators, academics, and public agency personnel, and support professionals.
4. **Labor-Management Counsel** – Attorneys in private practice serving as counsel for either management or labor. This year's award is for a **management-side attorney**.
